



School Uniform – There is a high standard of uniform at Esher High School. Tutors regularly check their tutor groups and students are expected to make their tutor aware of any problem they may have concerning uniform. Any medical reasons for a student not to wear full school uniform must be accompanied by a letter from the GP/Consultant and seen by our student's services team.

Boys

- Blazer:** Black blazer with badge
- House Badge:** As provided by the school
- School Tie:** Years 7, 8 and 9 - Red stripe **
Years 10 and 11 - Blue stripe **
- Trousers:** Plain black tailored trouser **
- Shirt:** Plain white school shirt
- Shoes:** Polishable low heeled black shoes. **See the school website for shoes that are acceptable.**
(No branding, trainers, canvas or boots).
- Socks:** Black or grey socks
- Jumper:** Black school V neck jumper with school logo (optional) **

Girls

- Blazer:** Black blazer with badge
- House Badge:** As provided by the school
- Skirt:** EHS Tartan skirt worn on the knee (not rolled at the waist)
- Trousers:** Black Trutex Boot Cut Trousers (optional) **
- Blouse:** Plain white open necked reverse cut blouse.
- Shoes:** Polishable low heeled black shoes **See the school website for shoes that are acceptable.** (No branding, trainers, canvas, boots, platforms or sling-backs).
- Tights:** Black or flesh coloured tights (not patterned)
- Socks:** Black or grey socks
- Jumper:** Black school V neck jumper with school logo (optional) **

School Uniform must be worn in an acceptable way.

- **Jewellery** - one small **stud** per **ear lobe** is the **only** jewellery allowed. Piercings in other places are not permitted eg. nose, tongue, stretcher or eyebrow stud. No diamante style jewellery. No exceptions will be made for a "new" piercing. No bracelets should be worn.
- **Make-up** - may be worn with discretion only in Years 10 & 11. No acrylic, gel or false nails of any description. Coloured nail varnish is not allowed.
- **Hair** - should be of an acceptable style, natural in colour and must be tied back for all practical lessons. No tram lines. Minimum cut of grade 2.
Boys should be clean shaven.
- **Hoodies** - must not be worn on the school site and will be confiscated for the day.
- **Belts** –plain black or brown with a standard buckle.
- **Coats** – should be dark in colour and have no patterns. Coats should not be worn in the classrooms.
- **School Bag** – should be a size that can take at least an A4 book/folder/file.
- **Chewing Gum** – Is not permitted anywhere on the school grounds.

Confiscated items can be collected from student services at the end of the day.

If in doubt about any of these points, please contact the school for clarification.

All personal items must be clearly named.

For September 2017, phasing in the new EHS uniform:

Year 11 girls: Have the option of continuing to wear the Black Trutex Stitch Down Pleat skirt as provided by our recognised uniform supplier.

Years 11 boys and girls: A school V neck jumper with logo can be worn instead of a blazer.
