SIXTH FORM (YEARS 12 & 13)

Formal dress (normal day wear)

- Shirts: plain white or of discreet, pastel colour, with collars (Y13 only may wear subtle pin stripes)
- White shirt for formal occasions
- **Sixth Form tie** (purchased from School shop)
Own choice of tie for some formal dinners/ events
- Dark business suits (dark grey, dark navy, black or charcoal) of conventional design or smart tailored trousers with matching jacket/blazer of conventional pattern. Jackets to have buttons, not zips. Tweed is not allowed
- Plain V-neck pullovers (not sweatshirts or sweaters with logos etc), dark in colour
- Shoes – black leather, conventional design
- Winter jackets, of one dark colour, without logos, with no fur trim on hood or cuffs
- Hair must be of a suitable length, tidy and look natural – not obviously tinted, treated or attention seeking
- Boys should be clean shaven
- Piercings must be removed during the school day
